## Administration Directions

- The student reads the words from the list, beginning with the first word. (Words may be read from Target Word flashcards, printed word list, or from Powerpoint.)
- The assessor says,"I want you to read some words. Please do the best you can. If you come to a word you don't know, skip it and go to the next one."
- No corrective feedback is provided. As needed, point to each word and say, "What word?" If the student misses a word or does not respond in 3-4 seconds, do NOT provide the correct word. As needed, point to the next word and say, "What word?"
- Mark correct words with a 1. Mark incorrect words with a 0. No responses and words not provided in 3-4 seconds are incorrect and also scored with a 0 .
- Continue testing until the student misses 6 consecutive words. If the student becomes unfocused, discontinue the testing session and resume at another time.
